EYFS GLD (Good Levels of Development)

EYFS GLD 73% PUPILS ACHIEVED (compared to 68% pupils nationally)

PHONICS CHECK (YEAR 1 & YEAR 2)

YEAR 1 PHONICS 80% PUPILS MET THE STANDARD (compared to 80% pupils nationally)

YEAR 2 PHONICS 93% PUPILS MET THE STANDARD BY END OF Y2 (89% National 2023)

MULTIPLICATION CHECK (YEAR 4)

YEAR 4 41% PUPILS SCORED FULL MARKS OF 25 (29% National 2023)

KEY STAGE 2 (YEAR 6) SATs - NATIONAL TEST/ASSESSMENT OUTCOMES

Pupils in Year 6 sit national tests, referred to as 'SATs', in May each year for reading, maths and GPS.

Writing is teacher-assessed against national guidelines.

To achieve the 'expected standard' for 10–11 year-olds, pupils need to score at least 100 in the SATs tests.

To achieve the 'greater depth standard', pupils need to score at least 110.
